From the heights the view of little see Iseo is impressive...Franciacorta supplies wines o quality rather than quantity. The dry white spumantes are renowned through out Italy; there are some powerful reds. Several vineyards welcome visitors. At Ricci Curbastro & Son in Capriolo, a museum of bygone tools and presses collected by the three generations of the family occupies three rooms of the Villa Evelina. You can buy wine by the case or half-case and they make the evil grappa too...”
